Project No.20021135. The Subcontractors List and written confirmation forms signed by the DBE subcontractors listed on the DBE Utilization Certification form must be submitted with the bid package within the deadline listed above. The bids will immediately thereafter be opened and publicly read -- in the Council Conference Room, CH149, unless otherwise posted. Bid Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered.

The Work to be performed shall include:

- Construction of approximately 1,000 linear feet of curbless Cement Concrete Roadway from 161st Avenue NE to Gilman Street transitioning to standard curb and gutter east of Gilman Street to 164th Avenue NE;
- Cement concrete pavers on Brown Street;
- 14-foot wide sidewalks on both sides of Cleveland Street where feasible;
- · Pervious paver band at back of flowline;
- Urban design elements such as catenary lights, benches, and bike racks;
- Landscape elements in pocket plazas containing trees, shrubs and other plantings;
- New Irrigation system;
- New pedestrian scaled illumination;
- Replacement of existing traffic signals and equipment at Leary Way and Cleveland Street;
- New corridor interconnect system;
- New storm drainage crossings;
- New 12-inch ductile iron water main;
- Joint utility trench work;
