## Idylwood Neighborhood Plan Update 2007 - 2010 DRAFT: Recommended Follow-up Projects and Future Considerations As defined by the Idylwood Citizen Advisory Committee Items to be further developed by Idylwood Neighborhood Residents

Following more than two years of study and deliberation, the Idylwood Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) completed their recommended updates for the Idylwood neighborhood plan. The CAC also identified several items that fit better as follow-up projects or future considerations rather than as policies in the Idylwood neighborhood plan. Without diminishing the value and importance of the items, the CAC elected to reserve the following items for additional review and future consideration as time and resources allow after adoption of the neighborhood plan update.

The Idylwood Citizen Advisory Committee shall initiate review of the following items with the City in order to establish additional priorities as defined in the list of Idylwood Neighborhood Priority Projects.
