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## CALL FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Redmond, Washington, at the office of the City Clerk, third floor, Redmond City Hall, 15670 N.E. 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, up to the hour of 2:00 PM on Thursday, [April 10, 2014] for the construction of Downtown/Redmond Way Regional Water Treatment Facility, Project No. 20020712. The Subcontractors List and, if required, written confirmation forms signed by the DBE subcontractors listed on the DBE Utilization Certification form (WSDOT form 272-056) must be submitted with the bid package within the deadline listed above. The bids will immediately thereafter be opened and publicly read -- in the Council Conference Room, CH149, unless otherwise posted. Bid Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered.

The Work to be performed shall include: Construction of approximately 1350 linear feet of storm drain pipe improvements most of which ranges in size from 24-inch diameter to 60-inch diameter, including but not limited to a below-grade stormwater diversion structure, below grade stormwater pump station, a below-grade stormwater treatment system for treating the Downtown Redmond drainage basin, a new stormwater outfall to the Sammamish River, associated power supply and SCADA monitoring, associated roadway and site restoration including traffic control loops, ADA ramps, driveway, sidewalk, and parking lot reconstruction, water and sanitary sewer line relocations, coordination with other utilities, demolition, removal of an existing stormwater treatment facility, shoring, dewatering and other work necessary to complete the Project. The project construction cost range is \$6,200,000 to \$7,100,000.


A pre-bid conference will be held at Redmond City Hall at [1:00 pm] on [Monday], [April 7, 2014]. All potential bidders are strongly encouraged to attend. Information from the pre-bid conference will not be made available to bidders who do not attend, but any changes to the Bid Documents made as a result of this pre-bid conference will be issued as Addenda and made available to all Bidders. Plans, Contract Provisions, addenda, pertinent supplementary information, and plan holders list for this project are available on-line through Builders Exchange of Washington at <http://www.bxwa.com>. Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder", in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the "Bidders List". All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified or cashier's check or surety bid bond made payable to the City of Redmond, for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid including sales tax, and all listed additives and alternates.

It is anticipated that this project will be funded in part by the Washington State Department of Ecology. Neither the State of Washington nor any of its departments or employees are, or shall be, a party to any contract or any subcontract resulting from this solicitation for bids.

The Successful bidder will be required to conform to the wage requirements prescribed by the federal Davis-Bacon and Relate Acts which requires that all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors performing on contracts funded in whole or in part by the SRF appropriations in excess of \$2,000 pay their laborers and mechanics not less than the prevailing wage rates and fringe benefits, and determined by the Secretary of Labor, for corresponding classes of labors and mechanics employed on similar project in the area.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bid or in the bidding process, and make the award as deemed to be in the best interest of the City.
