SUBJECT: RECREATION BUILDINGS MASTER PLAN STUDY SESSION

I. PURPOSE

City staff will brief the City Council about the Recreation Buildings Master Plan. The study session will include a PowerPoint presentation and project discussion about the recommended option, community input, and next steps in planning. The study session will be a joint presentation with Public Works, and will include the Facilities Condition Assessment.

II. BACKGROUND

This master plan is the second phase of the Recreation Buildings Design Study conducted by the department. The objective is to provide clear direction for the future of the four recreation buildings in Redmond - Senior Center, Old Fire House Teen Center, Old Redmond Schoolhouse Community Center and Redmond Pool at Hartman Park.

Based on City Council comments at the November 13, 2013 Study Session, staff and NAC | Architecture further evaluated the options for a building and associated structured parking on civic campus.

The Master Plan Recommended Option includes the following:


- Senior Center renovation and expansion
- Replace ORSCC and Hartman Pool with new community recreation center
- Replace teen center
- Additional study will be required for: arts facility/program needs assessment; building program for the Senior Center; building program and service delivery model for teen center

Key questions and policy considerations for Council:

1. Does the recommended option align with the City's priorities for recreation programs and services, and provide the desired service level for Redmond residents for the next 20 to 30+ years?

2. Does the recommended option provide the right balance of re-investing in existing buildings and investing in new buildings?

3. Does the recommended option offer Redmond residents the quality, value, and potential for appropriate financial performance?
