

RESOLUTION NO. 1155

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CERTAIN CONTRACTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS AND TO GRANT FINAL ACCEPTANCE FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS; AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 960.

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WHEREAS, Resolution No. 960 of the City of Redmond authorizes the Mayor to execute and grant final acceptance of public works contracts that do not exceed the limits requiring competitive bidding under state law, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 94, Laws of 2002, increases the limits under which competitive bidding of public works contracts is not required, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to increase the Mayor's authority accordingly, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.     Authority to Execute Public Works Contracts. Within budgetary limitations and without the need for further approval from the City Council, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute contracts for the performance of public works, where the total cost of the project does not exceed \$50,000 if more than one craft or trade is involved with the project, or \$30,000 if only a single craft or trade is involved with the project.

Section 2.     Acceptance of Public Works Projects. The Mayor is hereby authorized to grant final acceptance for all public works projects where the total cost of the project does not exceed \$50,000 if more than one craft or trade is involved with the project, or

\$30,000 if only a single craft or trade is involved with the project. No further council approval shall be required.

Section 3. Increase as of January 1, 2010. The limits set forth in Sections 1 and 2 shall be increased for all public works contracts entered into or finally accepted after January 1, 2010. The Mayor shall have authority to execute such contracts and to grant final acceptance for such contracts if the total cost of the project does not exceed \$65,000, if more than one craft or trade is involved with the project, or \$40,000 if only one craft or trade is involved with the project.

Section 4. Repeal. Resolution No. 960 of the City of Redmond, passed by the City Council on December 21, 1993, is hereby repealed.
