## RESOLUTION NO. 1210

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, TAKING A POSITION **SUPPORT** IN OF INITIATIVE PROHIBITING SMOKING IN BUILDINGS AND VEHICLES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT, INCLUDING AREAS WITHIN 25 FEET DOORWAYS AND VENTILATION **OPENINGS** UNLESS A LESSER DISTANCE IS APPROVED

WHEREAS, the Washington Clean Indoor Air Act prohibits smoking in public places except for certain facilities that may designate smoking areas; and

WHEREAS, bars, taverns, bowling alleys, tobacco shops and restaurants may be designated smoking areas in their entirety, and

WHEREAS, legislation to prohibit smoking in all indoor public places was considered by the Washington State legislature during the 2004 legislative session, but did not become law, and

WHEREAS, THE City has given due public notice regarding consideration of a position to the initiative including the number and title of the initiative, and has allowed equal time for expression of the opposing views; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES that the City Council of the City of Redmond takes an official position in support of Initiative 901.
