RESOLUTION NO. 1225

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING THAT THE KING COUNTY DIVISION OF RECORDS. ELECTIONS, AND LICENSING PRODUCE AND PUBLISH A LOCAL VOTER'S PAMPHLET FOR THE MAY 16, 2006 ELECTION AND INCLUDE THEREIN INFORMATION REGARDING THE REDMOND'S PROPOSED BALLOT PROPOSITION NO. 1 AUTHORIZING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY LID LIFT: AGREEING TO PAY THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE COSTS OF SUCH LOCAL VOTER'S PAMPHLET: AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION AND ALL OTHER REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR THE VOTER'S PAMPHLET TO THE KING COUNTY DIVISION OF RECORDS, ELECTIONS, AND LICENSING PRIOR TO MARCH 31, 2006.

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2006, the Redmond City Council passed City of Redmond Resolution No. 1224, calling for a special election to be held on May 16, 2006 for the purpose of presenting to the voters a ballot proposition calling for a property tax levy lid lift, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council has determined that a local voter's pamphlet would be a desirable way of providing information to voters concerning the ballot proposition, and

WHEREAS, the rules for local voter's pamphlets promulgated by the King County Division of Records, Elections, and Licensing provide that a city desiring that a local voter's pamphlet be produced and published for a local ballot proposition must request the same and agree to pay its share of the costs of producing and publishing the pamphlet, now, therefore,

Redmond hereby requests that the King County Division of Records, Elections, and Licensing produce and publish a local voter's pamphlet for the May 16, 2006 special election and include therein the information required by RCW Chapter 29A.32 for the City of Redmond's Ballot Proposition No. 1 regarding a property tax levy lid lift.

Section 2. Payment. The City of Redmond agrees to pay its share of the cost of producing the local voter's pamphlet requested by this resolution.

Section 3. Direction to City Clerk. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the King County Division of Records, Elections, and Licensing, together with any and all other information required for the local voter's pamphlet, including but not limited to, Resolution No. 1224, the explanatory statement, and the names of the committee members appointed by the City Council to prepare the statements for and against the ballot proposition. The City Clerk is directed to provide the information to King County prior to March 31, 2006.
