A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DECLARING WAIVING COMPETITIVE EMERGENCY. BIDDING REOUIREMENTS FOR INVESTIGATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RELEASE AT FIRE STATION 16 MAINTENANCE SHOP, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE EXECUTE CONTRACTS TO PERFORM THE SUBSURFACE INVESTIGATION WORK

WHEREAS, Fire Station 16 Maintenance Shop is located at 6205 185th Avenue NE in the City of Redmond, and

WHEREAS, The Redmond Fire Department ordinarily uses Fire Station No 16 Maintenance Shop to provide the full-range of apparatus repair and maintenance services for the City of Redmond and for King County Fire Protection District 34, and

WHEREAS, a hydraulic hoist is used to conduct maintenance on Fire apparatus, and

WHEREAS, a release of hydraulic fluid, a hazardous material, from the hoist cylinder has been discovered, and

WHEREAS, it is urgent to find out if the release of hydraulic fluid has impacted soil and groundwater beneath the facility, and

WHEREAS, a subsurface investigation of the soil and groundwater beneath the facility is required to discover if a plan for appropriate remedial measures is needed

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS

Section 1 Declaration of Emergency The Redmond City Council finds that the facts set forth in the recital paragraphs of this resolution are true and justify the declaration of an Pursuant to RCW 35 22 620(6) and RCW 39 04 280, the emergency City Council hereby declares and certifies that an emergency exists requiring the immediate investigation of a potential release of hydraulic fluid to soil and groundwater at Fire Without such immediate investigation, the Station No. 16 extent of the potential impact cannot be determined and plans, for the remediation of the release cannot needed. formulated, which results ın an increased risk to the groundwater resources of the City of Redmond

Section 2 Authority to Contract - Waiver of Competitive Bidding The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designees to negotiate and execute a contract or contracts to perform the necessary emergency repairs to Fire Station No 16 Pursuant to RCW 35 22 620(6) and RCW 39 04 280, any contrary bidding or selection requirements in State law or City ordinance are hereby waived due to the emergency nature of the work to be performed
