RESOLUTION NO. 1320

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE REVISED
ALL-HAZARDS COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Revised Code of Washington 38.52.070, authorizes and directs local jurisdictions to establish emergency management organizations and develop and maintain a local comprehensive emergency management plan; and

WHEREAS, the All-Hazards Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan provides the City with a method to address the City's preparedness for handling and responding to disasters and emergencies, and assisting citizens to be prepared in case of disasters or emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond All-Hazards Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan serves as the legal and conceptual framework for emergency management in the City of Redmond, and is ready for formal adoption by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this revised plan, staff from the City of Redmond will pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated herein; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources, seek to implement the

proposals contained within the revised Redmond All-Hazards Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond will continue to participate in the updating and expansion of the Redmond All-Hazards Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan in the years ahead; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond will further seek to encourage the businesses, industries, and community groups operating within and/or for the benefit of the City to also participate in the future updating and expansion of the Redmond All-Hazards Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan in the years ahead.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Plan Adoption. The Redmond City Council hereby accepts and approves the revised All-Hazards Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Redmond City Council.
