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FIRST-AMENDMENT TO THE EMERGENCY FIRE AND MEDICAL COMMUNICATION SERVICES AGREEMENT

Bellevue and the Contracting Agencies who are currently participants to an Interlocal Agreement for Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services (Agreement) hereby agree to Amend the Agreement as follows

1 The Second WHEREAS Clause is amended as follows

THIRD

WHEREAS, the parties have heretofore contracted with one another for the provision of emergency fire and medical communication services by Bellevue to the Contracting Agency, and are desirous of extending the service relationship for an additional two years through December 31, 2008, except as provided below, for the purpose of enabling the Contracting Agency to continue to utilize Bellevue's emergency fire and medical communication capabilities, and thereby continue to avoid unnecessary duplication of effort and expenditures of public funds, and

2 An additional WHEREAS is added as follows

WHEREAS, the parties acknowledge that Bellevue and certain Contracting

Agencies (as well as other public agencies) are in the planning stages of developing an
independent public agency (NORCOM) under the Interlocal Cooperation Act (RCW

39 34) to provide the communication services Bellevue currently provides pursuant to this
Agreement. Therefore, the parties further acknowledge that this Agreement is subject to
NORCOM's creation and operation as more fully set forth below

- 3 Paragraph 6 is amended as follows
- 6 <u>Communications Fire Annual Service Fee</u> The Contracting Agency shall pay a Communications Fire Annual Service Fee to Bellevue in 2007 for existing

services, as defined in Section 1, equal to the amount paid by the Contracting Agency in 2006, plus an inflationary adjustment. The inflationary adjustment will be the annual percentage increase in the Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton area CPI - All Urban Consumers published by the United States Department of Labor in August of the preceding year (Inflationary Adjustment). For each subsequent year that services are provided to Contracting Agency, it shall pay a Communications—Fire Annual Service Fee to Bellevue for existing services, as defined in Section 1 equal to the amount paid by the Contracting Agency in the preceding year, plus the Inflationary Adjustment

The calculation of the 2004 Communications - Fire Annual Service Fee is set forth in Exhibits A-G and summarized specifically in Exhibit H

- 4 Paragraph 7 is amended as follows
- Payment Terms The Communications Fire Annual Service Fee shall be payable one- half on or before May 15 of the service year, and one-half on or before November 15 of the service year. Invoices will be mailed no later than two months before these due dates. If payment is not received by the due date, a second notice will be sent by certified mail. If payment is not received within thirty (30) days of the date of the second notice, such payment shall be subject to an interest charge of ten (10) percent per annum, from the original due date of the payment. Provided however, should Bellevue terminate this Agreement due to NORCOM's creation and operation, Contracting Agency shall pay Bellevue for services provided under this Agreement through the termination date. Should the termination date be other than December 31, Bellevue will provide. Contracting Agency with a prorated statement for the amount owed to Bellevue or the amount Bellevue will refund.

- 5 Paragraph 8 is amended as follows
- Annual Service Fee Change By no later than September 15 of each year after the initial service year of this Agreement, Bellevue shall provide the Contracting Agency with notice of the Communications Fire Annual Service Fee to be charged for the next Service Year (e.g., the Communications Fire Annual Service Fee for service year 2008 shall be confirmed by no later than September 15, 2007) Such notice shall include copies of applicable sections of the Fee Allocation Worksheet upon which the fee calculation was based. The Board agrees to meet with Bellevue Police Department staff promptly following receipt of the Communications Fire Annual Service Fee notice by Contracting Agency, for the purpose of reviewing the Communications Fire Annual Service Fee calculation and discussing any significant changes from the prior year. Reasonable efforts shall be made to encourage attendance by all board members at such meeting
- 6 Paragraph 12 is amended as follows
- January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008 Provided however, the parties acknowledge that Bellevue and other public agencies are in the planning stages of developing an independent public agency (NORCOM) under the Interlocal Cooperation Act (RCW 39 34) to provide the communication services Bellevue currently provides pursuant to this Agreement Should NORCOM be formed and operational and Bellevue be a member of NORCOM, earlier than January 1, 2009, this Agreement will terminate as provided in Paragraph 19
- 7 Paragraph 13 is amended as follows

- Assignment No assignment or other transfer of any right or obligation under this Agreement shall be made by either party, and any attempt to so assign or transfer such right or obligation shall be a breach of this Agreement and the assignment shall be of no effect. Provided however, this paragraph shall not in any way impede or negatively impact NORCOM's creation, operation and/or Bellevue's and Contracting Agency's ability to terminate this Agreement as provided in Paragraph 19
- 8 Paragraph 19 is amended as follows
- 19 Termination Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice of its intent to terminate no later than the last day of a calendar year for termination to be effective on the last day of the following year. For example if a contracting agency wished to withdraw effective December 31, 2008, a written termination notice must be produced during 2007 and in no case later than December 31, 2007. In the event such written notice is given, this Agreement shall terminate and be of no further force and effect on December 31st of such final service year. Provided however, this Agreement shall terminate upon NORCOM being formed and operational and Bellevue becoming a member of NORCOM. Bellevue will provide Contracting Agencies with 90 days notice of the termination of this Agreement due to the creation and operation of NORCOM.
- 9 Paragraph 20 is amended as follows
- 20 <u>Effective Date</u> Upon execution by Bellevue and Contracting Agency(s), this Agreement shall take effect on January 1, 2007
- 10 All other terms of the Agreement shall remain the same and remain in full force and effect
