
Leading up to the meeting on May 20, City staff solicited opinions from area business owners via a freight mobility survey conducted in January and from key stakeholders during a February planning charrette.

Now we want to hear from you.



A fourth break out group will focus on roadways like NE 76 Street, the main east/west corridor through Southeast Redmond from Redmond Way to 192 Avenue NE.
