SUBJECT: **DONATION OF \$15,000 TO THE CITY OF REDMOND TO HELP FUND THE REHABILITATION OF THE HISTORIC ANDERSON PARK PICNIC SHELTER**

### I. RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Authorize the Mayor to execute an agreement with the Redmond Rotary Club to accept the cash donation of \$15,000 to partially fund the rehabilitation of the Anderson Park Picnic Shelter.

### III. DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND:

Anderson Park is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and the log picnic shelter is one of the primary contributing features. This structure has degraded over time and is currently being rehabilitated by a qualified contractor. The rehabilitation work includes replacement of rotten or missing logs, roof replacement, and repairs to the outdoor fireplace.

The Redmond Rotary Club has generously offered to donate \$15,000 in cash to help fund the Anderson Park Picnic Shelter rehabilitation. To recognize the Rotarians significant contribution to the project the Rotarians have requested a plaque be installed in close proximity to the newly renovated structure. The plaque will not exceed a dimension of 8" x 10" and all verbiage will be approved by the Parks and Recreation Director, or designee.

### IV. IMPACT:

A. **Service Delivery:** Approval of the Redmond Rotary Club's donation will result in providing adequate funding for the Anderson Park Shelter Rehabilitation Project. The rehabilitation and protection of this asset ensures it will be enjoyed by future generations.

**B. Fiscal:** The fiscal impact of the donation is reflected as a \$15,000 savings to the Park Operations General Fund Maintenance and Operations Budget.

**IV. ALTERNATIVES:**

**A. Do not approve the agreement:** If the donation is not approved, the rehabilitation project will be funded from both the Park Operations levy and general fund maintenance budgets.

**V. TIME CONSTRAINTS:**

The Redmond Rotary Club wishes to donate the funds prior to the completion of the rehabilitation project. Currently the project is tracking for completion in March 2011.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING A DONATION OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE REDMOND ROTARY CLUB FOR THE ANDERSON PARK PICNIC SHELTER PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO CARRY OUT THE TERMS OF THE DONATION.

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WHEREAS, the Redmond Rotary Club has graciously offered to donate the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) to the City for the Anderson Picnic Shelter Project, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Rotary Club has requested that its contribution be recognized by a plaque to be installed on or near the completed project, and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.21.100 authorizes the City to accept donations by ordinance and to carry out the terms of the donation if such terms are within the City's powers granted by law, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council desires to accept the donation according to its terms and to express its appreciation to the Redmond Rotary Club for its generosity, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance and shall not be codified.

Section 2. Donation Accepted - Terms. The Redmond City Council hereby accepts the donation of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) from the Redmond Rotary Club for the Anderson Park Picnic Shelter Project. The Mayor is hereby authorized to carry out the terms of the donation, specifically to (a) expend the funds on the Anderson Park Picnic Shelter Project, and (b) provide for the installation of a plaque recognizing the Rotary Club's donation on or near the completed project. The size and text of the plaque shall be subject to the Mayor's approval.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage and publication of summary consisting of the title.
