SUBJECT: **APPROVAL OF AWARD OF BID, 2011 STREET RESURFACING,  
PROJECT NO. 101567**

**I. RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Approve the award of bid for the 2011 Street Resurfacing, Project 101567, to Watson Asphalt Paving Co., Inc. of Redmond, Washington, for the amount bid of ~~\$1,329,440.60~~, and authorize the Mayor to sign the contract. \$1,320,440.60

**III. DESCRIPTION:**

The 2011 Street Resurfacing project was developed from the City's continuing Pavement Management Program. The Redmond Pavement Management (RPM) system uses visual pavement condition readings and information from the City's computerized database to identify streets most in need of resurfacing.

The attached vicinity map shows street locations of the 2011 Street Resurfacing project.

Also included in the project are the miscellaneous upgrades to the storm system in streets being resurfaced, the rechannelization of Avondale Way, adjustment of storm and sewer manhole covers in Redmond Way (SR 202) between 188<sup>th</sup> Ave NE and East Lake Sammamish Parkway, and removal of the rubberized railroad crossing and repaving at the intersection of NE 90<sup>th</sup> Street and Willows Road. In addition, there will be upgrades to the sidewalk ramps adjacent to the resurfaced streets. This is required to bring them up to the latest Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

The City Clerk received bids until 2 p.m., April 7, 2011. There were three (3) bidders and the bid totals are summarized below:

All bidder's unit prices, extensions and additions have been checked for accuracy and unbalanced bid items. Two bidders had minor errors in their extensions but it did not change the ranking of any of the bidders. The contractor's references were checked and found to be acceptable.

Staff recommends award to Watson Asphalt Paving Co., Inc., the low responsible bidder. Watson Asphalt has successfully performed numerous projects for the City.

**IV. IMPACT:**

**A. Service/Delivery:**

The intent of this project is to preserve and maintain Redmond's street system. The work to be performed this year will rehabilitate approximately three miles of neighborhood and arterial streets.

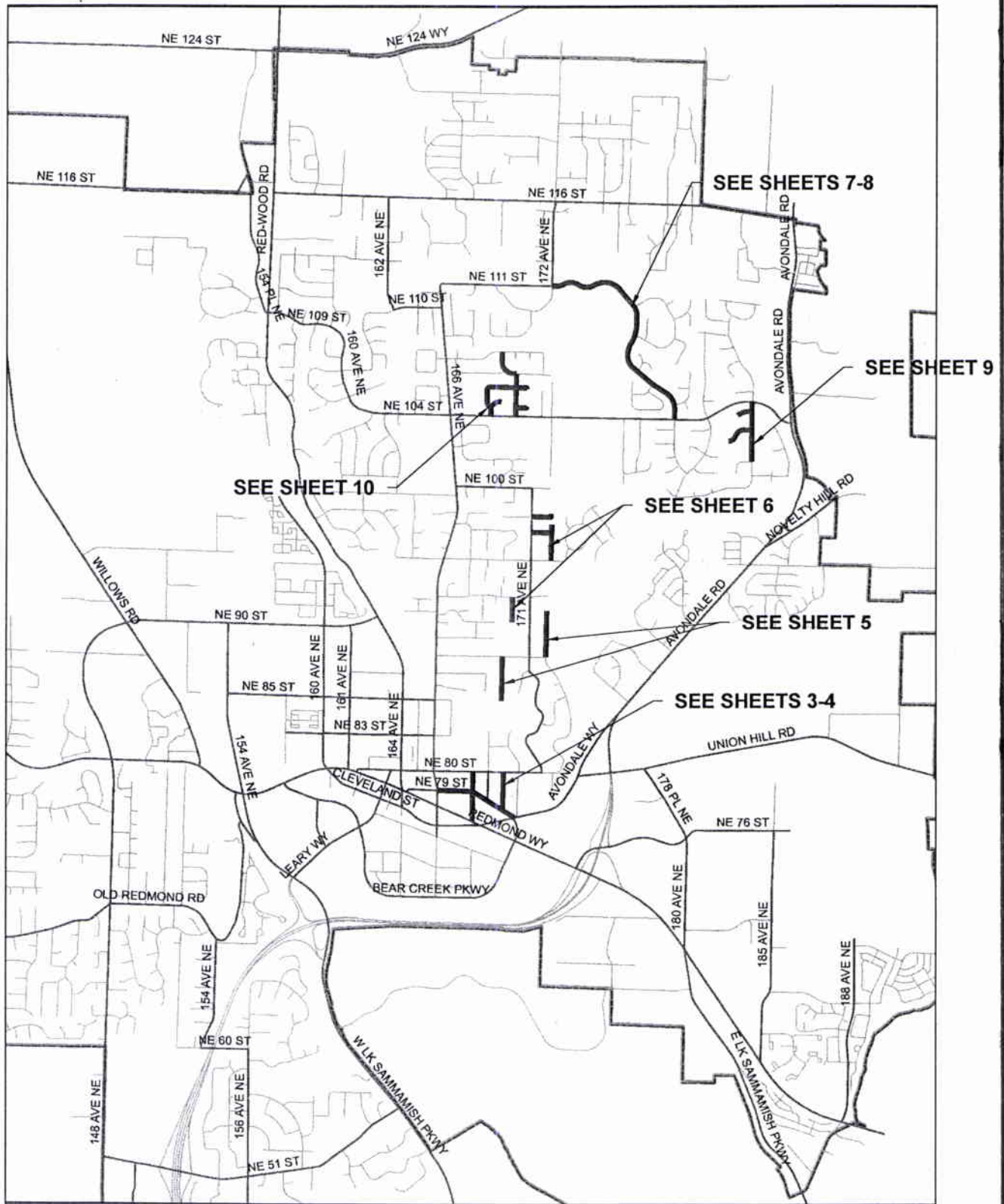
