ORDINANCE NO. 2643

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A NEW WATER SYSTEM PLAN, AMENDING THE REDMOND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO REFERENCE THE NEW WATER SYSTEM PLAN, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act requires that comprehensive plans and development regulations shall be subject to continuing evaluation and review; and

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2606 effective July 30, 2011, the City Council set the content of Redmond's 2011-12 Annual Comprehensive Plan Amendment Package, which includes this amendment; and

WHEREAS, a State Environmental Policy Act Checklist was prepared and a Determination of Non-Significance (L110237) was issued on June 29, 2011, for the 2011 Water System Plan; and

WHEREAS, state agencies received 60-day notice of the proposed amendment to the Redmond Comprehensive Plan and 2011 Water System Plan on September 12, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on September 28, 2011, to receive public comment on the proposed plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond desires to adopt the 2011 Water System Plan in order to encourage coordinated and

efficient development, and to ensure that adequate facilities and services will be available as development occurs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has prepared the 2011 Water System Plan which identifies where new or improved water facilities will be required to accommodate the anticipated growth within the City's service area, as well as expected costs for construction of these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond Water System Plan 2000 to 2010 will no longer be in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings, Conclusion, and Analysis. The City Council hereby adopts the findings and conclusions contained in the Planning Commission Report dated October 12, 2011, including all related attachments and exhibits to that report.

Section 2. Adoption of the Redmond 2011 Water System Plan. The City of Redmond 2011 Water System Plan is adopted as the City's Water System Plan and is attached as Exhibit 1 to this ordinance incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full. In addition, a copy of the 2011 Water System Plan shall be maintained in the Office of the City Clerk for inspection by the public.


Section 3. Adoption of Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The Capital Facilities Element of the City of Redmond Comprehensive Plan, Part F: Capital Planning References, is amended to adopt the 2011 Water System Plan by deleting "City of Redmond Water System Plan 2000-2010, May 2002" and inserting in its place "City of Redmond, 2011 Water System Plan, November 2011".

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title, or as otherwise provided by law.
