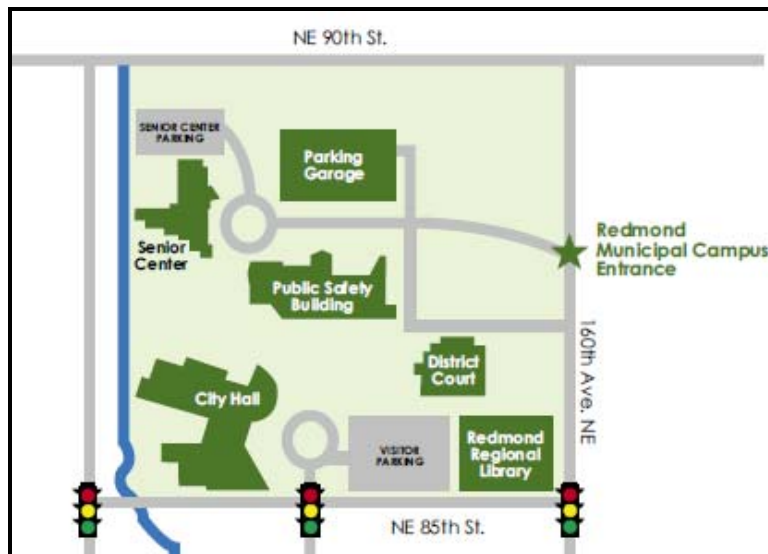


You are invited to attend a Neighborhood Meeting!

At the meeting the City of Redmond neighborhood traffic calming coordinator will...

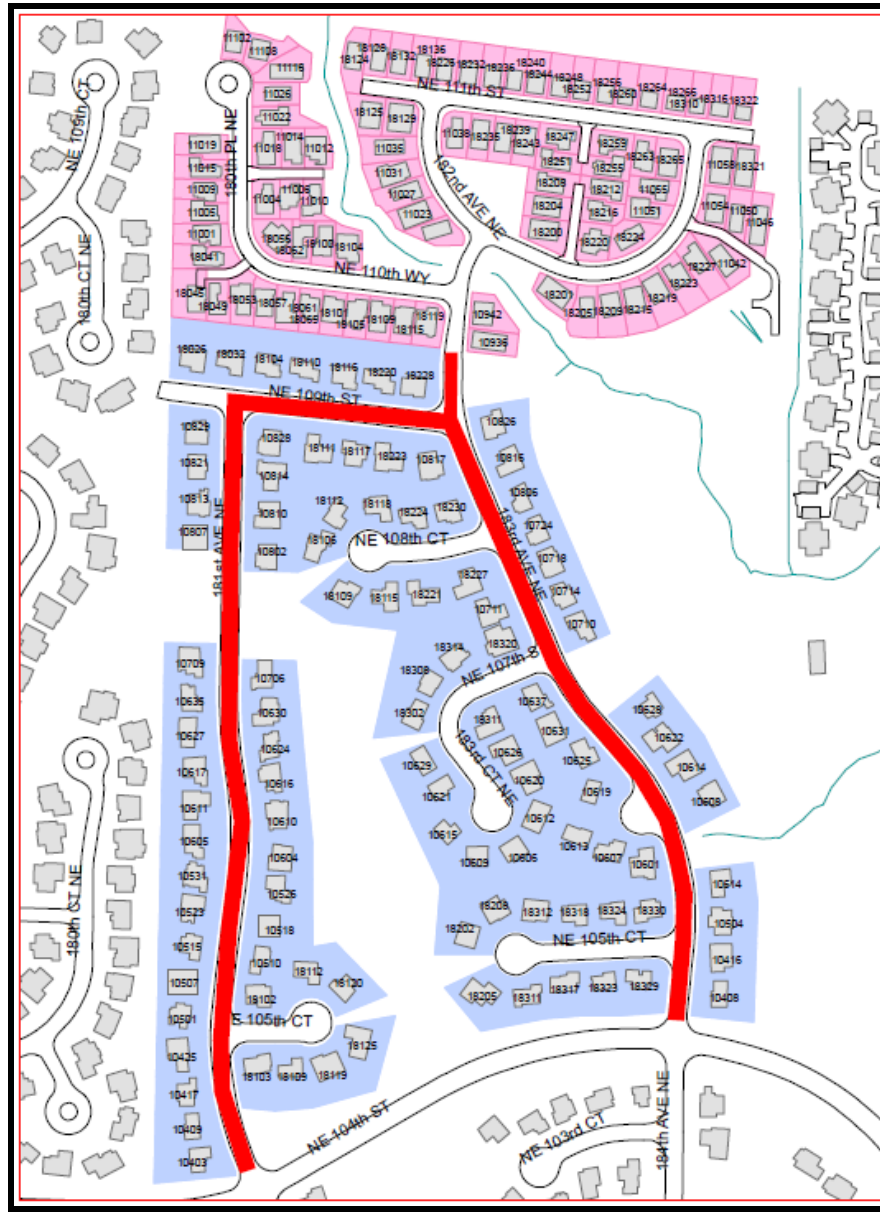
- Describe the City's minimum requirements for traffic calming devices

We will be discussing the following streets, which access the Tyler's Creek neighborhood:

- **183rd /184th Avenue NE, from NE 104th Street to the entrance to the Tyler's Creek neighborhood**
- **181st Avenue NE, from NE 104th Street to NE 109th Street**
- **NE 109th Street, from 181st Avenue NE to 183rd Avenue NE**

Those street segments are indicated in red on the map below. The Tyler's Creek neighborhood is shown in pink: Residents of both neighborhoods are invited to attend!
