Subject: 2022 Transportation Facilities Plan (TFP), Build-out Transportation Plan, Thoroughfare Plan and Growth Targets Amendment

BACKGROUND

The proposal would amend Redmond's Comprehensive Plan and Transportation Master Plan to update the City's 2022 growth targets and update the list of transportation facilities needed to support future growth. City Council last updated the 2022 employment target in 2006 and updated the 2022 Transportation Facilities Plan in 2007. As described in the attached Technical Committee report, these amendments are proposed to:

- Reflect updated neighborhood plans and recent and pending development activity.
- Respond with proposed updates to transportation plans to serve growth that is anticipated to occur between now and 2022 and between 2022 and 2030.
- Enable the City to more effectively carry out implementation actions for Redmond's Comprehensive Plan, including the pending Plan-Based Concurrency regulations.

The Planning Commission began review of this amendment at its May 27th meeting. On that evening, staff introduced the proposal and the Commission began identifying issues.

In addition, please review the following three items enclosed with your packet for this meeting: 1) errata sheet for staff's recommended amendments to the Transportation Master Plan, 2) FAQ sheet for the NE 40th Corridor Study, and 3) the separate memo for the West Lake Sammamish Parkway Corridor Study and the recommendation from members of the Viewpoint and Overlake Citizens Advisory Committees.

At the June 10, 2009 meeting, the Commission will hear public comment as part of the public hearing and will have an opportunity to ask additional questions and identify and discuss identified and new issues.
