HOW TO REGISTER

Walk-in registration is accepted for Redmond residents beginning Tuesday, April 6, 2010 at 9:00 am and for non-residents beginning Tuesday, April 13, 2010 at 9:00 am at the Old Redmond Schoolhouse Community Center located at 16600 NE 80th Street, Redmond, WA 98052. Plots are assigned on a first come first served basis.



Juel Park is named for benefactors Glen and Betty Juel who purchased the 38 acres in the early 1950s. Throughout the years, the couple raised vegetables, blueberries and flowers amongst the 100 year old trees. In 1999, the Juels sold the property to the City of Redmond at a fraction of market value so their beloved land would remain green and open forever.
