The work to be performed under this contract shall include rehabilitation of the existing Pump Station No. 1. Work will include replacement of mechanical, electrical and structural components as well as providing new power service to the station, and other work as required to complete the project. The engineer's estimated cost range is \$450,000 to \$550,000.

Contractors are **required** to attend the pre-bid conference and site visit scheduled for 10:00 AM (local time) on Thursday, July 8, 2010 at Redmond City Hall, 15670 NE 85th Street, Redmond, WA, 98073.

Sealed bids for this project will be received by the City Clerk, Third Floor of the Redmond City Hall, 15670 NE 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, until Thursday, July 15, 2010. Proposals will then be opened and publicly read for the construction of improvements in the Council Conference Room, CH149, unless otherwise posted. Any proposal received after the opening will not be considered.

Plans, specifications, addenda, bidders list, and plan holders lists for this project are available through the City of Redmond on-line plan room. Free of charge access is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to "<http://bxwa.com>" and clicking on "**Posted Projects**"; "**Public Works**", "**City of Redmond**", and "**Projects Bidding**". Bidders are encouraged to "Register" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the "Bidders List". This on-line plan room provides bidders with fully usable on-line documents with the ability to download, print to your own printer, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources (on-line print order form), and a free on-line digitizer/take-off tool. All proposals must be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Redmond. The City of Redmond reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities in the bid or in the bidding.

No bidder may withdraw his proposal after the hours set for the opening thereof, or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding forty-five (45) days.
