1. Welcome by Chair Nick Roy (6:30 pm)

2. Featured Item – NE 24th Street Buffered Bike Lane Design (6:40 pm)

The City is considering enhancing the bicycle facility along a one mile stretch of NE 24th Street in the Overlake neighborhood. Anticipated outcomes include improving the bicycling experience and calming vehicle traffic.

The current facility consists of a bike lane along the shoulder on both sides of the roadway, adjacent to a sidewalk. Staff has generated a *preliminary conceptual design* of a buffered bike lane (173rd Ave NE to West Lake Sammamish Parkway). Features of the facility include:

- 5 ½ foot bike lane separated from the roadway by a 2 foot buffer
- Buffer demarcated by durable, thermoplastic paint
- Two-way left turn-lane replaced by left turn pockets at key locations

Public Works staff Andrew Scales and Gina Schroeder will give an overview of this potential bike/ped project and walk PBAC through the design sheets (see Attachment 2). PBAC members will be asked for feedback. Committee feedback is considered valuable at an early stage of the planning process as it can identify potential issues and opportunities and provide important cycling insights.
