**2. Featured Item – Eastrail Overview and Update (6:35-7:15 pm) (Informational)**

Eastrail is a regional trail planning effort intended to connect communities throughout the Eastside. Built along a historic railroad line, Eastrail will offer 42 miles of trail, opportunities for non-motorized recreation, and connections to transit, job centers, green space and housing.

Redmond's portion of the trail is the Redmond Central Connector (RCC), which currently runs through Downtown Redmond and connects to the Sammamish River Trail. The City participates in the Eastrail Regional Advisory Committee (RAC), along with Bellevue, Kirkland, Renton, Woodinville, King County, Snohomish County, and other jurisdictions and community groups.

Parks and Recreation Senior Planner Jeff Aken will give an update on the trail planning effort, provide an overview of the City's role on the RAC, and share some insight into what's lies ahead for the RCC and other trail segments in 2021 (see Attachment 2).

This is an informational item, and PBAC will have an opportunity for Q&A.

This item is a continuation of the discussion topic started at the January 11 meeting.
