Changes to Planning Commission Meetings During the Month of April

Following the Governor's Stay At Home Proclamation and guidance from King County Public Health regarding social distancing, the City is taking the following steps for Planning Commission meetings during the month of April:

- **On March 23, 2020, the Governor issued a Stay at Home order (Proclamation 20-05), effective through April 8th. The April 8, 2020, meeting will be a REMOTE ONLY meeting to comply with this order (online or via phone).** On April 2, 2020 the Governor extended the order to be effective through May 4, 2020. If the order is extended further, it may affect additional meetings and this extended agenda will be updated accordingly.
- **The Council Chambers will be closed**, per the Governor's Proclamation 20-28, waiving the in-person setting requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, to help curtail the spread of the COVID-19 and to enable essential City business to continue during the Stay at Home order.
