3. Featured Project – King County Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade (7 pm)

In October 2018, King County staff introduced PBAC to the sewer upgrade project and shared related draft plans for pedestrian and bicycle detours. PBAC reviewed and commented on initial proposals, with special focus on the Sammamish River Trail closure (SR 520 south to Marymoor Park). PBAC suggested providing a shorter, more direct connection; utilizing existing, dedicated bike/ped facilities; and incorporating enhanced wayfinding measures (e.g. vicinity maps of the detour areas).

In June 2020, City staff updated PBAC that King County was developing alternate routing as part of the overall project resubmittal and would bring revised detour plans back for comment in the Fall.

At today's meeting, the Lake Hills/NW Lake Sammamish project team will present updated plans for pedestrian and bicycle detours during construction, with specific attention given to the Marymoor Park 3-mile detour alternative.
