RESOLUTION NO. 1467**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 2 OF RESOLUTION NO. 1460 IN ORDER TO DELETE THE LIMITATION ON THE FORM OF THE CONTRACT TO BE ENTERED INTO BETWEEN FABRICATION SPECIALTIES LTD. AND THE CITY FOR THE DOWNTOWN PARK PAVILION STRUCTURE AND TO REVISE THE PROPOSED AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1460 of the Redmond City Council, passed by the City Council on December 6, 2016, waived competitive bidding for the Downtown Park Pavilion Structure because the unique nature of the structure qualifies it as a special facility under RCW 39.04.280; and

WHEREAS, at the time Resolution No. 1460 was passed, the work proposed was contemplated as a public work and the resolution therefore requires that the City's standard construction contract was to be entered into with Fabrication Specialties Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, upon further review, the Public Works Department has determined that certain work can and should be shifted to the general contractor performing the other site work on the Downtown Park project and that the contract with Fabrication Specialties Ltd. does not need to be a construction contract; and

WHEREAS, shifting the work as determined by the Public Works Department will allow the contract amount for Fabrication Specialties Ltd. to be revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of Resolution 1460. Section 2 of Resolution No. 1460 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Authority to Contract. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to negotiate and execute a contract or contracts with Fabrication Specialties Ltd. for the fabrication and installation of integrated artwork at the Downtown Park pavilion structure, pursuant to the single-source justification provided in this resolution and the scope of work and pricing information set forth in the agenda memo presented to the City Council with this resolution. The contract shall [~~BE THE CITY'S STANDARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AND SHALL~~] not exceed [~~[\$1,700,000]~~] \$1,500,000.

Section 2. Other Provisions to Remain in Effect. Except as expressly modified by this resolution, all other provisions of Resolution No. 1460 remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
