RESOLUTION NO. 1472**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CONCERNING THE SELECTION OF A SPECIALIZED CONSULTANT TO ASSIST THE CITY WITH CONDUCTING A LEAN PROCESS FOR THE CITY'S CAPITAL PROJECT DELIVERY SYSTEM AND SUBSEQUENT CONTRACTING WITH SAID CONSULTANT TO PERFORM THE WORK

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond regularly delivers a 6-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) valued at more than \$30 million annually; and

WHEREAS, the delivery of the City's CIP involves the work of City staff located in multiple divisions and departments within the City, performing complex activities in the planning, design, construction and operational phases for capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the City's CIP processes have evolved over time and contain opportunities for increased efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the City can realize these opportunities for increased efficiency, effectiveness, and transparency in the performance of CIP project delivery work by conducting a Lean process to examine its work processes using Lean principles and practices, and to identify ways to improve these work processes; and


WHEREAS, the City has identified a specialized consultant, Mr. Steve Gorcester, who is uniquely qualified to assist the City.

Section 1. Authority to Contract. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to negotiate and execute a single source contract with Mr. Steve Gorcester for training City of Redmond staff on Lean principles and for facilitating the City staff through a Lean Process on the City's capital project delivery methods and procedures. This contract will provide the City with recommendations on how to improve our capital project delivery processes by increasing transparency and efficiency, reducing costs, and increasing our ability to consistently meet our performance targets.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
