**CITY OF REDMOND
ORDINANCE NO. 2875**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CREATING THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF TECHNOLOGY AND INFORMATION SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE POSITION; SPECIFYING THE DUTIES OF THE POSITION; AMENDING PAY PLAN "E" IN ORDER TO INCLUDE THE DIRECTOR OF TECHNOLOGY AND INFORMATION SERVICES POSITION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City's information services, risk management, and technology functions are currently performed by the City's Finance Department; and

WHEREAS, the information services, risk management, and technology functions have grown significantly in recent years and the Mayor has recommended that a new City department be created and that the department be managed by a Director of Technology and Information Services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Position Created - Appointment and Duties.

The position of Director of Technology and Information Services is hereby created in order to oversee and manage a Technology and Information Services Department providing information services,

risk management, technology support, and such other City functions as may be determined by the Mayor. The Director of Technology and Information Services shall be appointed and supervised by the Mayor and shall be required to take an official oath or affirmation and furnish a bond as required by RCW 35A.12.080.

Section 2. Executive Pay Plan "E" Amended. Pay Plan "E" covering Executive Employees, as previously amended by Ordinance No. 2854, passed by the City Council on December 6, 2016, is hereby amended to include the new position of Director of Technology and Information Services. The amended Pay Plan is attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper or as otherwise provided by law.


