ORDINANCE NO. 2876**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING  
RMC 2.02.050, APPOINTMENT OF DEPARTMENT HEADS,  
TO CODIFY THE POSITION OF TECHNOLOGY AND  
INFORMATION SERVICES DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, the City desires to create a Department of Technology  
and Information Services; and

WHEREAS, ordinances are being brought forward to enact the  
department and the position.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,  
WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a  
general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City  
Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Subsection. RMC 2.02.050,  
Appointment of Department Heads, is hereby amended to read as  
follows:

**2.02.050 Appointment of department heads.**

The positions of Chief of Police, Fire Chief, Personnel  
Director, Finance Director, Planning Director, Public  
Works Director, ~~[AND]~~ Parks and Recreation Director, and

Technology and Information Services Director, and all other positions of department head level which may hereafter be established shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the City Council, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper, or as otherwise provided by law.


