APPROXIMATE FUNDING AVAILABLE

The City of Tukwila anticipates allocating approximately \$420,000/year of General Fund dollars for the 2021-2022 funding cycle.

FUNDING PRIORITIES AND GOALS

The City of Tukwila recognizes the need to support agencies that meet basic human service needs and welcomes applications from agencies that provide such services to Tukwila residents. Those programs best able to demonstrate solid outcomes for participants will be viewed most favorably. In addition, the Advisory Board will only review applications that meet the following funding priorities:

Wellness – (Physical, mental, dental, wellbeing) – behavioral health counseling, trauma recovery, medical and dental services, crisis support

Housing - homeless prevention (legal/financial), outreach, tangibles, shelter, transitional, day centers,

Food Security – regular access to healthy food distribution site, food delivery for isolated ill, frail seniors, emergent food bags

Support for Independence - training/employment supports, ESL, case management, transportation, childcare supports, agency capacity building, mentoring, citizenship

ALL applications are due by Tuesday, April 7 at 4:30 PM. LATE APPLICATIONS OR CORRECTED PAGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Agencies seeking to provide services within a Tukwila School, that are not currently providing services within a Tukwila School, must first submit a letter of support from the Tukwila School District PRIOR TO APPLICATION.

Tukwila has several shared zip codes; none are exclusive to Tukwila. If a new application is being considered for funding, Human Services staff will request addresses of Tukwila residents served to ensure correct data prior to moving application forward in the review process.
