What: Grant Writing Clinic

When: March 31, 2020, 3- 7 pm, by appointment only – space is limited.

Where: Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Avenue, NE, Bellevue, WA 98004

This grant writing technical assistance program is designed to support community-based nonprofit organizations that serve communities impacted by systemic oppression and do not have the internal capacity to hire a grant writer or have staff dedicated to grant writing.

We will be providing 45-60 minutes of free consultation with a grant writer consultant to give you feedback and editing advice on your draft proposal.

Who is eligible for grant writing technical assistance?

This clinic is intended for nonprofit organizations that are submitting a proposal for funding through the Human Services RFP that:

- Have budget of \$500,000 or less;
- Serve communities impacted by systemic oppression, which includes communities of color, immigrant and refugee communities, LGBTQ communities, persons with disabilities;
- The organization's service area includes Bellevue, Kirkland, Redmond, Sammamish and/or Issaquah;

Preference will go to organizations whose leadership (Leadership Staff and Board of Directors) reflect the communities they serve and meet the criteria above.
