- Commissioners, staff, and the public will have the option to attend the meetings remotely utilizing appropriate technology;
- Anyone in attendance will be asked to practice social distancing; and
- Information only agenda items may be provided in written form rather than in person.

The Council Chambers will continue to be open to the public during Planning Commission meetings in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act.
