**CITY OF REDMOND
ORDINANCE NO. 3005**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL
CODE SECTION 10.24.065, SCHOOL ZONES, TO
LENGTHEN THE SCHOOL ZONE AT ALBERT EINSTEIN
ELEMENTARY

WHEREAS, the Albert Einstein Elementary School Principal and
the Redmond Police Community Engagement Sergeant has recommended
and the extension of the school zone boundary to the east; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond aims to identify more appropriate
limits of the NE 116th St school zone location; and

WHEREAS, this change will better encompass a main walking
route to and from the school.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a
general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City
Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Subsection. RMC 10.24.065,
School Zones, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.24.065 School zones.

Notwithstanding any contrary speed limit provided in the schedule established by Section 10.24.060, the speed limit on the following portions of City streets serving schools shall be 20 miles per hour, when appropriate signs indicate, or when control lights are flashing and signs indicate:

State Route No./City Street Designation	Traffic Direction	From	To	Maximum Speed
NE 116 Street	Both ways	300 feet east of [MARKED] <u>the</u> school [CROSSWALK] <u>property line</u> located at 182 AVE NE [THE EAST LEG OF 179 COURT NE]	300 feet west of marked school crosswalk located at the east leg of 179 Court NE	20 mph

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective five days after its publication, or publication of a

summary thereof, in the city's official newspaper, or as otherwise provided by law.


