- Redmond 2050 web: **1,965** visits
- Virtual Lobby: **2,319** visits  
266 visits to alternative lobby
- Let's Connect Site: **1,236** individuals informed;  
302 engaged participants
- Email subscribers: 534 subscribed;  
**1,568** delivered messages (6 bulletins)

# Community Workshop



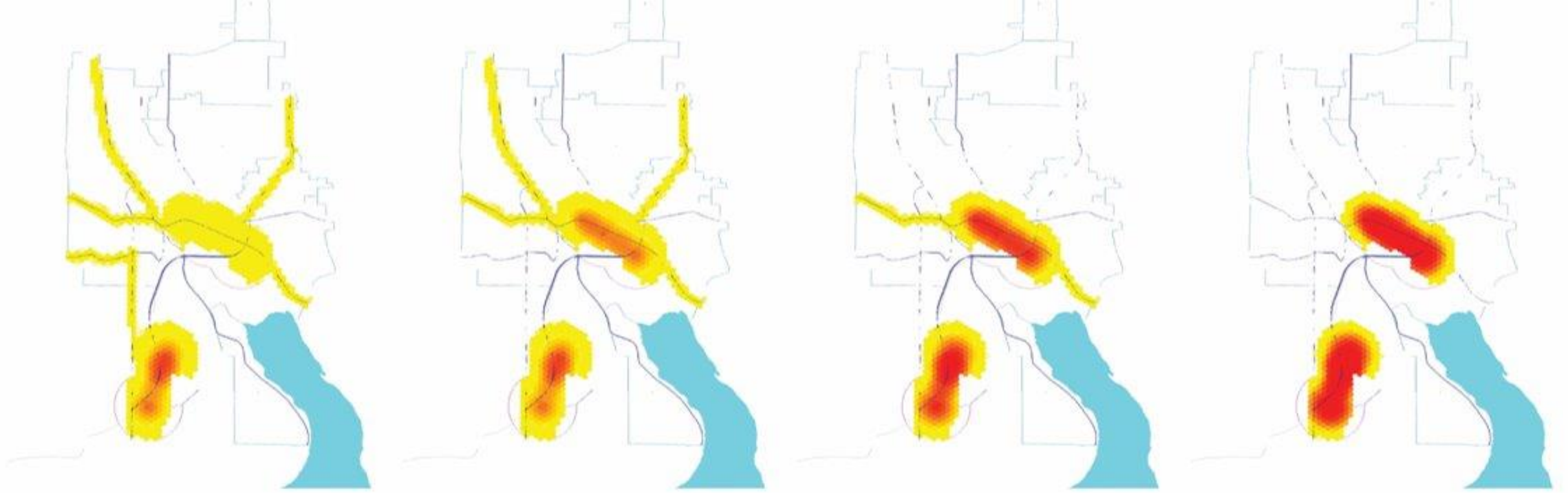
- Over 100 registered and over 60 attended

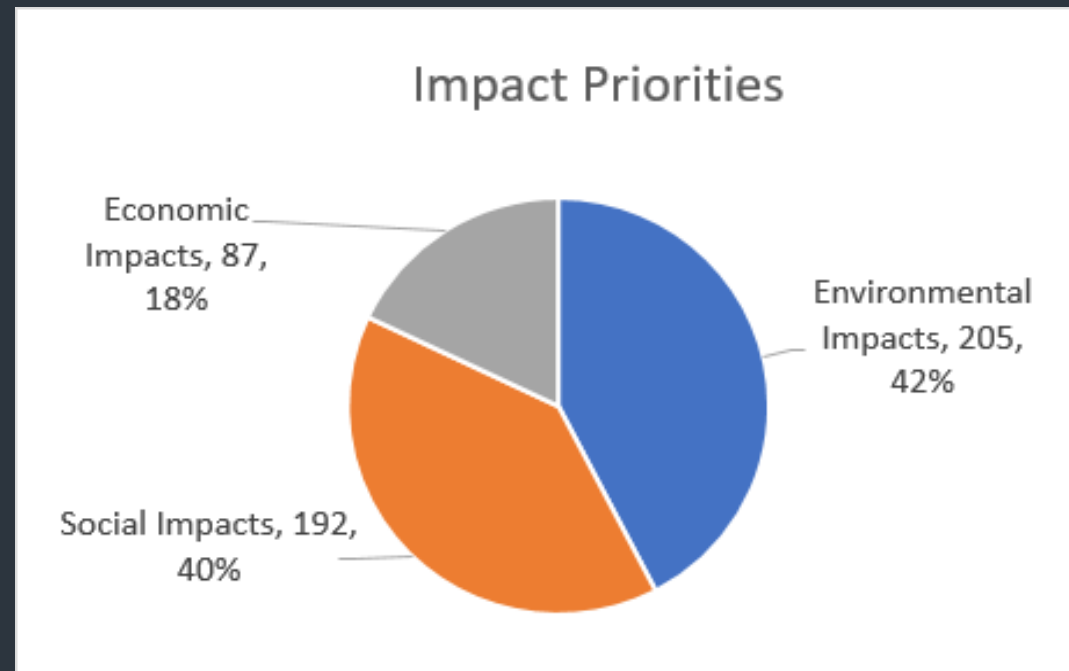


# Growth Model Demonstration

Community feedback on where and how much growth should go in different locations in Redmond.

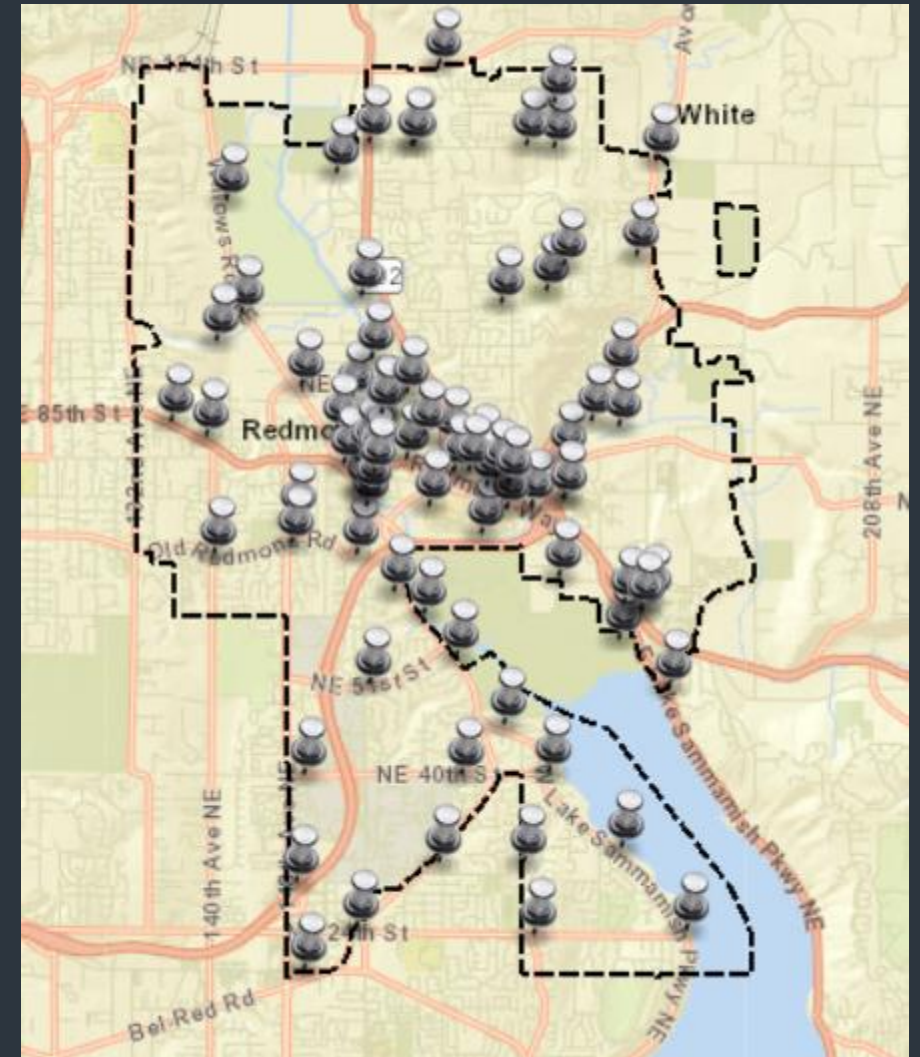
# SEPA Scoping Questionnaire
