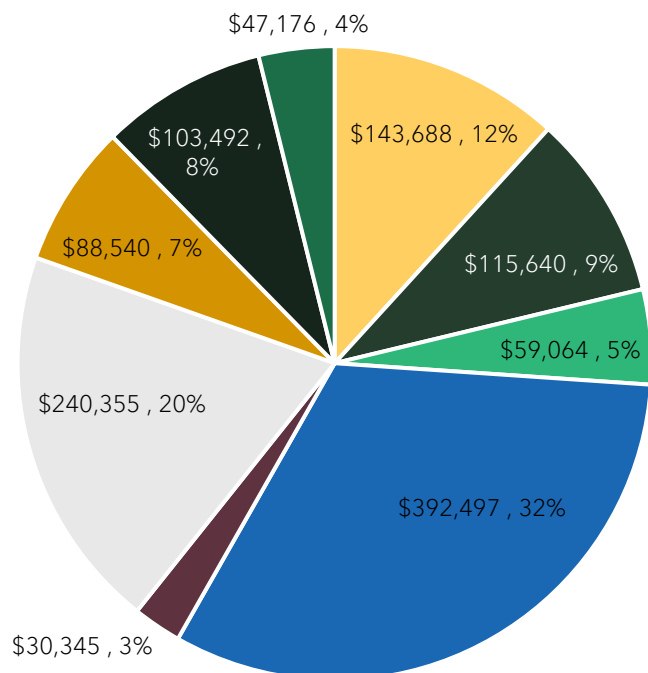
Contract Performance
