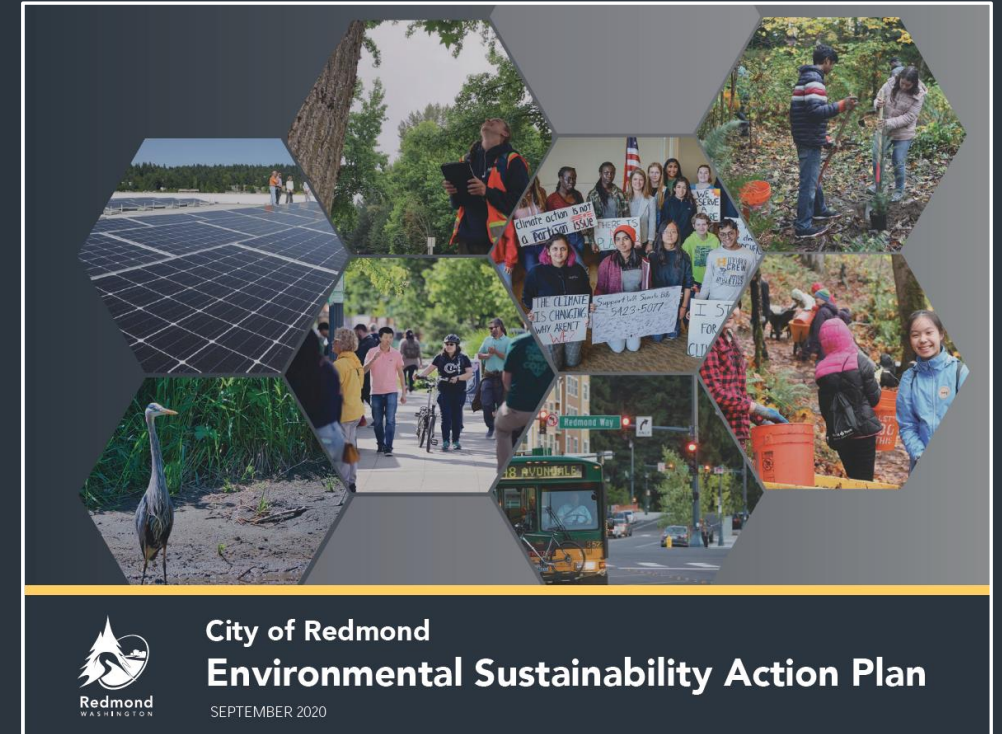


# **Climate Vulnerability Assessment**



# Background

- Climate Vulnerability Assessment an action item of the 2020 Environmental Sustainability Action Plan
- Coordination between Sustainability and Long-Range Planning staff has resulted in a contract amendment to expand the Redmond 2050 work to include this Assessment





# Objectives

- Identifying climate change impacts and risks in the Redmond area
- Analyzing these impacts' effects
- Prioritizing Redmond's vulnerabilities
- Providing guidance on next steps
- Providing a tool for future analysis
- Identifying strategies to create a more resilient community.





# Goals

- Identify vulnerabilities associated with climate change
- Identify communities and populations that may be especially vulnerable to climate impacts
- Identify how to incorporate resiliency measures into capital improvements and operational practices
- Develop an interactive vulnerability map to support City planning & outreach efforts
- Prepare a resiliency strategy

- Narrative, dataset, and GIS-based maps
- Data and analysis for Growth Scenario analysis and Environmental Impact Statement
- Vulnerability matrix
- Resilience Strategy
- Climate Vulnerability Assessment Final Report; and
- GIS-based tool

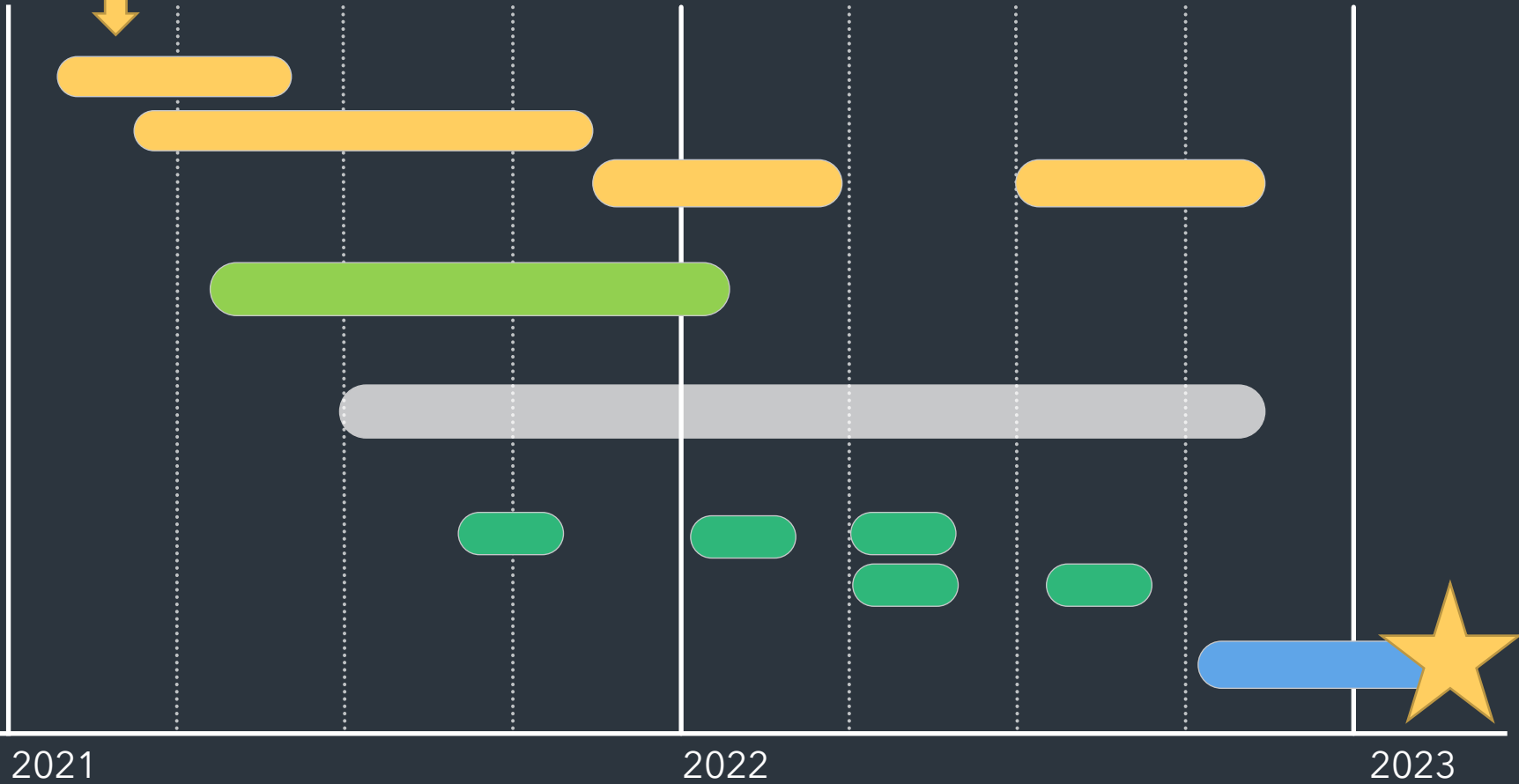
