#### Public Safety Committee 2018 Goals

- Improve policies and strategies related to public safety categories of:
  - Affordable housing; homelessness and related services; drug use
  - Impacts of city growth on fire and police services
  - Emergency preparedness with a focus on risks related to climate change.
  - Automobile, bicycle and pedestrian safety (Vision Zero)
- Enhance and broaden areas of public engagement
  - Continue to work closely with downtown businesses and residents.
  - Improve outreach and dialogue with all Redmond neighborhoods.
  - Ensure all Redmond community groups and cultures are included in public engagement
  - Build stronger CERT participation.
- Maintain high level of service and public safety with optimal funding
  - Better inform the priorities for the 2019/2020 budget (Evaluate change dynamics of city growth, social changes, buildings and infrastructure, disaster preparation)
  - Improve operational metrics to better inform on service performance and resource needs.
  - Improve traffic safety and traffic flow
