Dear Resident,

Wastewater Lift Station 12, located just west of Bell Marymoor Park Apartments, is nearing the end of its useful life. Therefore, the City will abandon this lift station and build a new one 300 feet to the north of the existing station. The goal is to start construction later in June or early July of 2021 and conclude construction in the Spring of 2022. This project is not expected to impact power, water, phone lines, or any other non-sewer utilities during construction.

Residents near the project site can expect traffic detours and delays during construction along 180th Place N.E. Working hours are anticipated to be Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. The City will remove the vegetation on the new pump station site, and the finished site will be landscaped.
