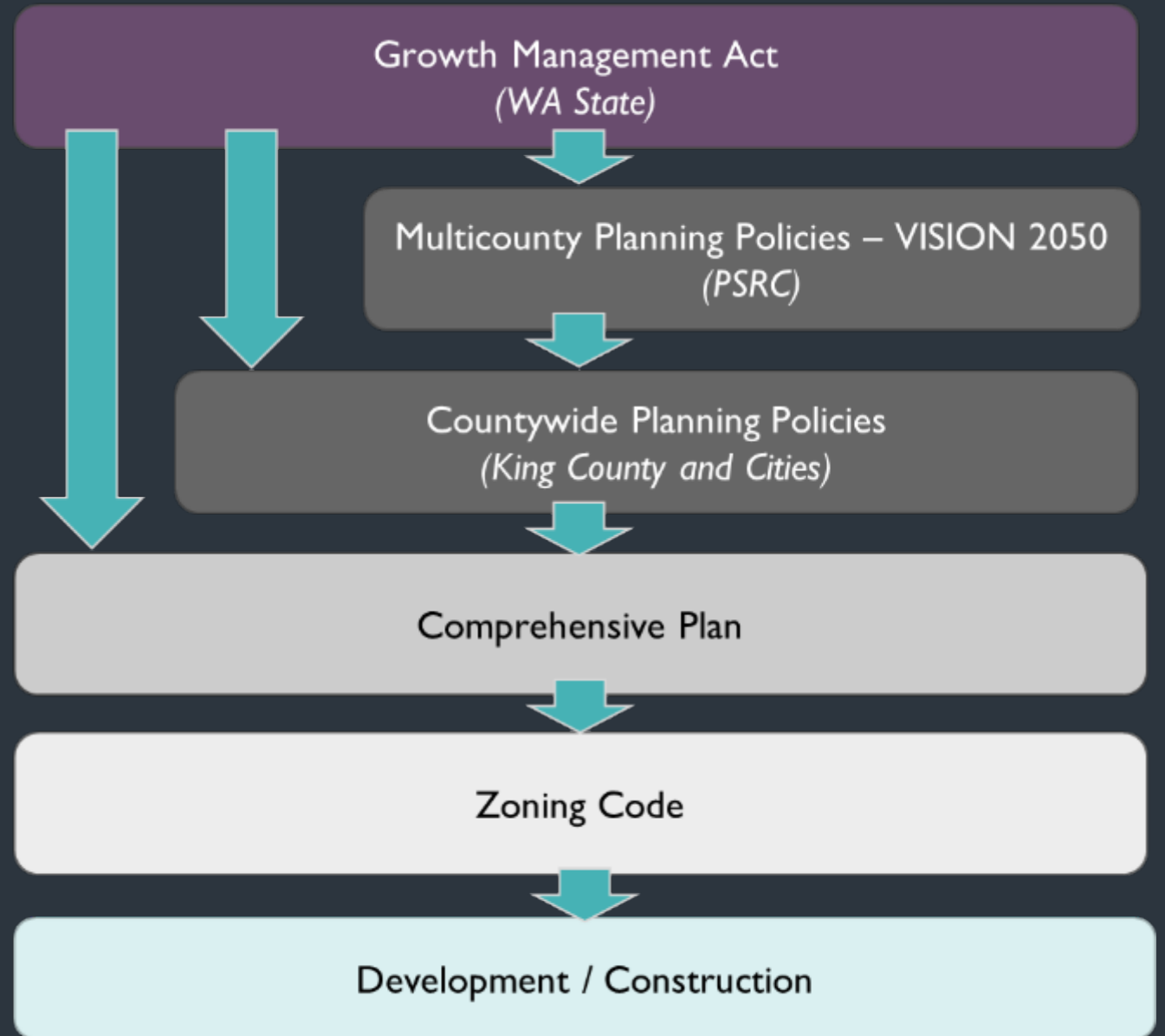


Purpose

Implementing the Growth Management Act

Redmond 2050 must be consistent with all state and regional requirements and be certified by PSRC



PARCC Element and PARCC Plan

- Two Integrated Parts:
 - Update PARCC Element for Redmond 2050 which informs the PARCC Plan update
 - Update Functional Plan (PARCC Plan)



Requirements (RCW 36.70A.070)

- **Element must include:**
 - Estimates of park/recreation **demand**
 - Evaluation of **facilities and service needs**
 - Evaluation of **regional coordination** to meet parks/recreation demand.



Estimates of Demand

- Statistically valid survey
- Short-term counts
- Field/shelter reservation capacity



Level of Service

- Overhauled in 2017
PARCC Plan
 - Service Areas
 - Children's Play Features
 - Sports & Fitness Features
 - Outdoor Sports Field and Picnic Shelter Use Rates
 - Urban Parks



Regional Coordination

- Regional trails/Eastrail
- Regional aquatics
- Cricket
- Weighted evaluation of Level of service based on neighboring jurisdictions facilities.
