**Subject:** Redmond 2050 Monthly Briefing

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### PURPOSE

This month's Redmond 2050 briefing introduces significant changes that Commissioners will see in the first drafts of the Housing, Economic Vitality, and Transportation Elements.

### FIRST DRAFT HOUSING, ECONOMIC VITALITY, AND TRANSPORTATION ELEMENTS

Publication of the first draft Housing, Economic Vitality, and Transportation Elements is a major milestone in Redmond 2050. It also represents the culmination of multiple rounds of community and stakeholder engagement, beginning with a November 18, 2020 community workshop on Redmond's future. Major parts of the process are recapped in following graphic.
