Notice of Public Comment Proposed 2023 Community Development Block Grant Projects

The City of Redmond will receive Public Comment on proposed 2023 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects. The opportunity to comment will be held on June 27, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. at Redmond City Hall, 15670 NE 85th Street, Redmond, WA 98052 and via **telephone** by contacting abien@redmond.gov, no later than 4:30 pm on June 27, 2022, with your name, phone number, and a request to comment on the proposed 2023 CDBG projects. Staff will reply confirming receipt and, during the meeting, will call the number you provided to connect you.

Public comment can also be made in **writing** by submitting written comments to Alaric Bien, PO Box 97010, Redmond, WA 98073 by June 27, 2022 or via **email** to abien@redmond.gov by 4:30 pm on June 27, 2022.

The City of Redmond will allocate approximately \$237,585 in 2023 CDBG funds to projects that are consistent with the objectives and policies of the King County Consortium Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan for 2020-2025 and federal regulations. The City is proposing to allocate 2023 CDBG funds to the following projects:

- \$40,963 for homeless services provided by Congregations for the Homeless. CDBG funds will support the services and operation of an emergency shelter for homeless men on the Eastside at 515 116th Ave NE, Bellevue, WA.
- \$155,659 for A Regional Coalition for Housing, which will select specific housing development projects through a separate request for proposal process. King County will publish a public notice describing projects selected by ARCH and invite public comment for 14 days before the Joint Recommendations Committee takes action on the project.
- \$40,973 for City of Redmond, CDBG Program Administration, 15670 NE 85th St, Redmond, WA. CDBG funds will be used to administer the City of Redmond's CDBG program activities.
