Subject: Transportation Master Plan (TMP) Update

PURPOSE

Staff will reintroduce the Transportation Master Plan update, review the TMP update schedule for 2023, describe engagement initiatives and their overlap with Redmond 2050 engagement, and provide an update on what to expect.

TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIES & GUIDING PRINCIPLES

The Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan and the TMP contain four strategies, established in 2021:

- Organize around Light Rail
- Maintain Transportation Infrastructure
- Improve Travel Choices and Mobility
- Enhance Freight and Service Mobility

The TMP also has five guiding principles, which include all of the Redmond 2050 themes:

- Safety
- Equity and Inclusion
- Sustainability
- Technology Forward
- Resilience

DEVELOPING THE TMP

During 2023 staff will focus on three efforts that will inform major components of a fully-updated TMP: a Local Road Safety Plan, Active Transportation Plan, and Transportation Facilities Plan. Other major work will be completed on transportation demands and street classifications.

LOCAL ROAD SAFETY PLAN

Having a Local Road Safety Plan (LRSP) is a requirement for the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) City Safety Grant program. It is a proactive data-driven analysis to address fatal and serious injury crashes and systemic safety needs in the city. Having an LRSP demonstrates making progress toward Vision Zero by prioritizing the risk factors that cause the city's fatal and serious injury crashes, safety risk countermeasure projects, and other programmatic actions.
