TERMINATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER

MANDATORY VACCINATION OF CITY FIREFIGHTERS AND PARAMEDICS

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020, Washington Governor Jay Inslee issued Proclamation 20-05 proclaiming a State of Emergency for all counties in the State of Washington as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak in the United States and confirmed person-to-person spread of the disease; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2021, I issued Executive Order Mandatory Vaccination of City Firefighters and Paramedics, which was subsequently updated on November 1, 2022, by Second Executive Order Regarding Mandatory Vaccination of City Firefighters and Paramedic; and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2023, I terminated Second Executive Order Regarding Mandatory Vaccination of City Firefighters and Paramedic;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANGELA BIRNEY, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM:

The Executive Order Mandatory Vaccination of City Firefighters and Paramedics, issued September 30, 2021, is also hereby terminated.
