

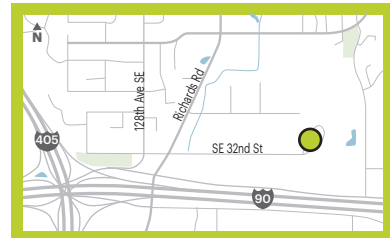

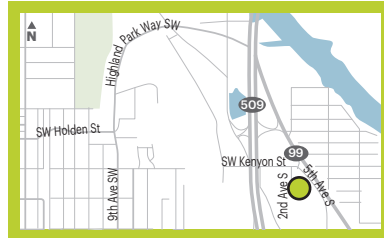

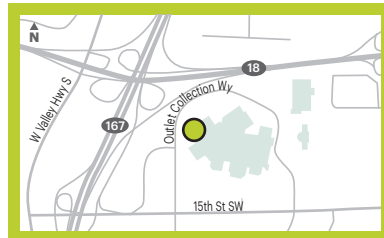

Hazardous Waste 101

If the products you use have labels with one or more of the following **WORDS**, you have hazardous waste!



Your business is eligible to use the free disposal service if it is a small quantity generator (SQG) in King County.

SQGs produce less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month and never accumulate more than 2,200 pounds per year at their site.**

Qualifying businesses can make **up to 4 visits per year**. Load limits are **25 gallons** or **220 pounds** per visit. Fill out a **Business Disposal Form** on our website prior to drop-off.






What to bring

*quantity limits apply

 Adhesives and glues	 Antifreeze or automotive products	 Batteries* Sort by type: lead-acid, alkaline, button, lithium and rechargeable batteries. Note: Tape the ends of the lithium and rechargeable batteries or place each one in a sealed plastic bag (50 lb limit)	
 Chlorine and oxidizers	 Cleaners	 Corrosives	 Flammable products
 Fluorescent lights* (Limit 10)	 Lawn and garden products	 Marine flares* (Limit 10) Not accepted at Wastemobile	 Mercury products
 Oil-based paints and stains	 Paint thinner and other solvents	 Pool and spa supplies	 Propane tanks and fire extinguishers* (5 gal limit)

What **NOT** to bring

 Asbestos-containing materials	 Contaminated soil	 Electronics, TVs, and computers	 Empty containers
 Explosives (fireworks, ammunition, gunpowder, explosive powder)	 High pressure cylinders over 1 liter	 Latex or water-based paint Dry latex or water-based paint by mixing cat litter into can, then put in trash when solidified. Throw lid away.	
 Medical sharps	 Tires	 Unknown or unlabeled wastes	 Radioactive wastes

Important: Laboratory chemicals, organic peroxides, and highly hazardous or unusual wastes require pre-approval.
