

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED LEGISLATIVE ACTION**  
**CITY OF REDMOND**

The Redmond City Council is scheduled to take action on proposed changes to the Redmond Zoning Code and Redmond Municipal Code. This action will occur as part of the Council's regular meeting on Tuesday, April 16, 2019, in the Council Chambers, 15670 NE 85<sup>th</sup> Street, Redmond, Washington at 7:30 p.m.

The proposed amendments provide a periodic cleanup to portions of the Redmond Zoning Code (RZC) and Redmond Municipal Code (RMC). The amendments correct typographical errors; address inconsistencies or missing references to other portions of the RZC, RMC, and state and federal regulations; and revise outdated place names, terminology, and identifiers.

The proposed minor corrections to the Code are limited to amendments that:

- Clearly maintain the intent, purpose, and direction of current regulations;
- Are limited in scope, scale, and to small, isolated portions of the Code; and
- Rely solely on existing Code for clear and concise direction for administrative interpretation.
