## PRESSURE WASH WASTEWATER DISPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

(Redmond Municipal Code 13.06)



Surface Being Cleaned	Wash Wastewater Disposal Requirement	Other Requirements/Suggestions
All surfaces cleaned using corrosives, or other harmful chemicals, or that may have hazardous materials (e.g. lead paint) on it	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><span style="color: red;">✘</span> NO DISCHARGE TO STORM DRAINS</li> <li><span style="color: green;">✔</span> Wash wastewater must be contained collected and recovered for approved off-site disposal</li> </ul>	Disposal of wastewater containing hazardous substances must be appropriately documented (retain disposal receipts)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parking lots</li> <li>Roadways</li> <li>Driveways</li> <li>Drive-thrus</li> <li>Loading docks</li> <li>Dumpster &amp; Compactor Areas</li> <li>Any other potentially polluted surfaces</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><span style="color: red;">✘</span> NO DISCHARGE TO STORM DRAINS</li> <li><span style="color: green;">✔</span> Discharge to sanitary sewer equipped with pretreatment device (oil/water separator, interceptor, filters, etc.) or collected for approved off-site disposal. Contact your local sewer authority for specific details 206-477-5300</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* No discharge to septic systems</li> <li>* Collect/recover wash wastewater</li> <li>* Wash wastewater must be filtered for oil, sediment, and debris before discharging to sanitary sewer</li> <li>* Heated water and detergents okay to sanitary sewer</li> </ul>
Outdoor eating areas or sidewalk cafes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><span style="color: red;">✘</span> Discharge to storm drains of heated water, detergents, soaps, or other additives is prohibited</li> <li><span style="color: green;">✔</span> Discharge to storm drains allowed if wash wastewater is filtered (e.g. catchbasin insert filter)</li> <li><span style="color: green;">✔</span> Discharge to sanitary sewer may be required if the surface has excessive staining and/or other pollutant build-up that may contaminate stormwater</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Sweep up or vacuum loose debris prior to pressure washing</li> <li>* Discharge wash wastewater to landscaped areas if possible</li> <li>* City may determine excessive pollution is occurring and prohibit storm drain discharge</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pedestrian-use sidewalks, with typical dust, moss, and algae build-up</li> <li>Building exteriors</li> <li>Roofs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><span style="color: red;">✘</span> Discharge to storm drains of heated water, detergents, soaps, or other additives is prohibited</li> <li><span style="color: red;">✘</span> Extremely muddy or turbid wastewater bypassing filtration is prohibited</li> <li><span style="color: green;">✔</span> Discharge to storm drains allowable if wash wastewater is filtered</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Discharge wash wastewater to landscaped areas if possible</li> <li>* City may determine excessive pollution is occurring and prohibit storm drain discharge</li> </ul>
